Our commitment to your safety

All the Student Community Partnership members have been working hard to put in place measures in our buildings and on our campuses to make them Covid-secure, for students, staff and the wider community.

This includes social distancing, reducing numbers on public transport and on our campuses, using one-way routes and maximum occupancy restrictions, and creating Covid-compliant study and recreation spaces in town.
